Citizens Input

Dave Kowalkowski addressed the board requesting he be allowed to haul sap exceeding the 14,000 pound weight limit on town roads. He asked that adjustments be made to the current restrictions because of statistics he kept last spring showing temperature variations that gave evidence that the current restrictions often did not work. He is therefore requesting adjustments be made to the time frame of the load limits.

Chairman Chitko placed a call to Howard Young who said he was hesitant to deviate from the original ruling because others may then ask for additional adjustments opening up the board to possible problems. It was decided that a special meeting would be scheduled to address this issue upon the return of Chairman Young.

Walter Leja reported on topics of discussion by the FCEDP and how it would affect us in Armstrong Creek and Forest County.

Chris Frydrych reports February 2019 receipts of \$283.38 and disbursements of \$273,610.21 (includes tax settlements). Scott Goode made a motion to approve treasurer's report and Don Chitko seconded that motion. Approved.
